### **CONGRATULATIONS AGAIN!!**

Our records show that we have not received a claim for your share of last year's jackpot. Your share of the jackpot is **US \$ 135,856.00**. This claim is now seriously overdue and must be made immediately to avoid prize disqualification. If a claim is not sent to us right away, your file will be closed without further notice.

Our review shows that you were allocated ticket number M9071 for the final draw held on December 30, 2006. Your share of the prize is **US \$ 135,856.00** (One hundred Thirty Five Thousands Eight Hundred Fifty Six Dollars). As required by the government, this prize must be claimed by you within a period of six months of the draw date.

We **STRONGLY** advise you to claim your prize within the next two weeks. The money is currently held by a government authorized clearing house and will be released when you place a claim against it. To start the claim, call this toll-free number **1-800-719-9137** or **1-204-952-1508** and ask for Mr. David Freeman, your claim processing agent.

To guarantee the funds, the government requires that winners pay a bond equivalent to 2% of their prize money to the clearing house. These funds must now be paid by you **before** your prize is released. We do not know your financial situation, but our experience has shown that payment of this bond causes undue hardship to some. To address this our department usually encloses a standard check for **US\$ 3975.00** to be used to cover the required 2% bond which is 2717.12 and any expenses one might incur while we process their prize money. **DO NOT** process the enclosed check before calling your Claim Agent for **confirmation**.

CONGRATULATIONS once again from all of us here thank you for being a part of our internationally renowned award program.
